

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how OncoDNA SA (“**OncoDNA**”) collects and uses information from users of OncoDNA’s website (available at www.oncodna.com – the “**Website**”), as well as the purpose of such collection and use. OncoDNA is committed to ensure your privacy, will safeguard the information you supply and use it only in accordance with the following provisions, and in compliance with applicable privacy and personal data protection legislation. This Privacy Policy may be amended by OncoDNA from time to time and you are therefore invited to review it periodically.

Categories of personal data processed and purpose of processing. By accessing or using the Website, OncoDNA may process certain personal data relating to you, such as your first and family names, email address, subject and content of messages that you sent to OncoDNA through the contact form on the Website. You acknowledge and, where necessary, agree that these personal data may be collected and processed for the purposes of offering you the services available on the Website, contacting you and answering to your queries.

Transfer of personal data.
